It is great that you plan to attend Summer Assembly with your youth group.

Summer Assembly is a week long camp, held on a college campus, providing an opportunity for you to grow in your knowledge and Christian faith.

The day starts with personal morning devotions, followed by an elective session. Electives are taught by youth leaders and spiritual adults dealing with topics that meet your needs and impact your life.

Town Hall, follows, with a fun time for the whole camp to come together and have some friendly entertainment. This typically involves some type of game or comedy.

Another electives session is held, before lunch. Then after lunch, there is a time of recreation. This time of recreation typically involves some type of competitive events amongst pre-assigned teams. These events can include water games, tournaments, inflatable games, and relays.

Following supper is the main session with a time of praise and worship, and a message from the week's main speaker. This is followed by some type of whole camp activity, such as youth group time, all camp campus game, interactive worship, or a coffee house with a talent show.

We do prefer that you attend with your youth group, not as an individual. Therefore, you will need to register through your youth leader. This includes submitting the registration fee, *Registration Form* and *Medical & Liability Form* through your youth leader.
